A WORD FROM OUR CEO




In July, I had the privilege of bringing the entire Visit Beloit leadership team to Chicago for the annual Destinations International convention. More than 2,000 professionals from across the U.S. and around the world gathered to exchange ideas, expand industry knowledge, network with peers, and draw inspiration from a powerful lineup of speakers.

Among the most impactful were two men whose stories are transforming lives through extraordinary paths.


Justin Wren, once a bullied child, rose to become an MMA champion, but his real fight began off the mat. After years battling addiction and depression, Justin reached a low point during a suicide attempt in Mexico. Through a series of lifechanging events, he found healing while living with the Mbuti Pygmy people in Congo. That experience sparked a mission: serving marginalized communities. His nonprofit, Fight For The Forgotten, has since brought clean water to more than 52,000 people, secured land rights, planted forests, and built sustainable systems for healthcare, housing, and education. Justin's message is simple yet powerful; turn pain into purpose and struggles into service.

Andre Norman, known as the "Ambassador of Hope," grew up entrenched in gang life and was sentenced to more than 100 years in prison. But it was in solitary confinement that he had a turning point. Determined to change, he taught himself to read, earned his GED, studied law, and eventually

graduated from Harvard University. Today, he works with global organizations and at-risk communities, sharing how transformation is possible through self-discipline, vision, and compassion. His passion lies in second chances, mental



I share these stories because they challenge us to be resilient, to push against the status quo, and to seek joy and meaning in the one life we have. Each of us faces personal and professional hurdles, but as a destination community, we can rise and work

The lodging industry remained unsettled through the first half of 2025. Occupancy rates in 2025 were 60.4% in April, 64.4% in May, and 70% in June compared to 62.6%, 62.6%, and 70% in 2024, respectively. The average daily rate was marginally ahead in the quarter, averaging \$123.56 versus \$122.84 in 2024. Lastly, total revenue generated by lodging properties was nearly even to year as it was up 0.96% in the quarter with \$5,164,629 compared to \$5,115,364 in 2024. Disclaimer: This data provided by STR, LLC is only to be used for analysis and is not inclusive of all lodging property types and is only relative to lodging properties in the city of Beloit.

FINANCIALS

As of June 30, 2025, Visit Beloit, Inc.'s total assets equaled \$1,323,992.49 which includes \$887,827.95 in current assets, \$417,162.04 in fixed assets, and \$19,002.50 in other assets. Total liabilities are \$63,490.56, therefore total organizational equity equaled \$1,260,501.93.
